<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Kobus explained that Valley Farm is implementing a clocking system for internal use and all fingerprints will be taken. Tinus required if there is any legal reason why the database may not be shared with the SAPS. Kobus indicated that he will find out. Captain Matsane confirmed that the SAPS needs an original copy of fingerprints. The SAPS will do a background check on all workers. ✓ Kobus stated that Hi-Tech also offers the service to do a background check on all workers. They indicate if the workers have pending charges or any criminal record. ✓ Captain Matsane stated that you can apply to cancel any old criminal records. ✓ Kobus stated that better security measures will be implemented from next year as this year is already late and the crops need to be harvested without any riots from workers.

6. Patrols

- ✓ Tinus confirmed that Raymond and himself did two patrols with Captain Matsane and a patrol was arranged with Craig Diack on Saturday.
- ✓ Captain Matsane will come to Kingstonsvale on a Friday / Saturday evening and will do routine patrols with the residents.
- ✓ The routine patrols will be logged as a joint OPS at the main CPF and get the area nominated. The SAPS is understaffed and therefore Captain Matsane might be called out on short notice.
- ✓ Tinus spoke to Callum and he said HI-Tech will join the Patrols, if they do not have to attend to paying clients. Tinus requested volunteers to avail themselves for patrol.
- ✓ Abigail to create a register for Patrols.
- ✓ Tinus stated that a 50% cover on all patrols mean that there will be on average four patrols per month.
- ✓ Tinus offered to be available as a backup most of the time. Clint also stated that he is on standby.
- ✓ Raymond requested one person to drive the patrols. One person must coordinate the volunteers for the month. Everybody need to get involved.

- ✓ Tinus was nominated as the coordinator.
- ✓ Matsane stated that he knows the area now so it will be easy to liaise patrols.
- ✓ Hi-Tech also need to be informed with every patrol.
- ✓ Everybody was very positive. The only person who was not happy with the presence of the SAPS was Shiela Ndlovu.
- ✓ The patrols work. There was not one pedestrian while patrolling.
